MARVI RESOLVES TO SOLVE GB ISSUES

ASTORE: Minister of State and Chairperson Benazir Income Support Program (BISP), MNA Marvi Memon on Thursday said that uplift of Gilgit-Baltistan (GB) is top priority of the incumbent government.

During her visit to district Astore here, she said that the present government is committed to solve the problems and challenges faced by the masses at their door steps.

She said that Prime Minister Nawaz Sharif has directed special initiatives for development of Gilgit-Baltistan adding that he (Prime Minister) will announce a package for the area during his visit.

Chairperson BISP ensured the beneficiaries of the program that their payments will be released within a month and assured that payments will be made through a transparent manner.
