



## **1. PAK POST EXTENDS EMO SERVICE TO ITS 83 GPOS**

Islamabad Pakistan Post has extended electronic money order service to its 83 general post offices across the country.

Pakistan Post initiated Electronic Money Order (EMO) Service for domestic money transfer in order to cater to the costumers requirements. The service allows customers for quickly transferring money within the country, an official of Pakistan Post told APP. He said customers were able to transfer money up to Rs 100,000 through EMO Service at very nominal charges ranging from Rs 50 to Rs 600. He said that all the financial services of the department would be launched online through Centralized Software Solution (CSS).

He said that pension benefit certificates and Behbood certificates of the National Savings would also be sold through the post offices and an agreement is being executed with National Savings Directorate for sale of National Saving Certificates at Postal Counters. He said that new call centers had also been opened for facilitation of the customers in Multan, Rawalpindi and Peshawar.

Computer cell actively engaged in expansion of computerization of postal services he added. *He said that BISP, Military Pension Payment System and Saving Bank would be shortly implemented in Centralized Software Solution platform.*

During the current year, Pakistan Post introduced a number of new computerized mail and financial services. He said that the department was providing a number of computerized services to meet the present day requirements.

Pakistan Post having country wide network where others simply cannot reach provides efficient, cost effective, secure services to the people and organizations, he said. APP
