Marvi says govt committed to empowering women

CHITRAL: Benazir Income Support Programme (BISP) Chairperson Marvi Memon on Wednesday said that the government was encouraging private sector to boost the country's economy.

Speaking to the BISP beneficiaries at different places in the district, Marvi Memon said that programme was being included in the BISP to facilitate skilled women to introduce their products to the outside world through internet.

"The main objective of the

BISP is to encourage entrepreneurship and empower women," she maintained.

She said that introducing local products to the outside world would revolutionise local economy and self-employment.

Marvi Memon said that another survey for the BISP would be conducted within two years to widen the beneficiaries' net and facilitate women in far away villages to get their money through identity cards at focal points. Commenting on the slow pace of development work in the district, she said that her party would form government

in the province after the next general elections.

The Pakistan Muslim League-Nawaz leader said that the government would take steps to include Khwar in the list of national languages

Speaking on the occasion, Member National Assembly Shahzada Ifikharuddin said that the recent floods and earthquake had destroyed the poor infrastructure in the district, which was developed soon after partition. However, he lauded the efforts of the PML-N government for allocating huge funds for development of the district.
