



NEW POVERTY SURVEY OF BISP: MARVI VOWS SUPPORT TO BALOCH PEOPLE

BISP under directions of Prime Minister Muhammad Nawaz Sharif and Finance Minister Senator Ishaq Dar will ensure that Balochistan gets equity in the new poverty survey.



This is possible only if remote areas of Balochistan are covered well in the new survey. This was stated by Minister of State and Chairperson BISP, MNA Marvi Memon, while addressing a gathering of elected members of local bodies, notables and BISP beneficiaries at Turbat in Balochistan. A statement issued here on Monday said that the Chairperson BISP's visit is part of beneficiary outreach campaign just ahead of launch of pilot

phase of National Socio-Economic Registry (NSER) update.

In this connection, she had already visited Sukkur, Jacobabad, Naseerabad, Dera Murad Jamali, and Qila Saifullah earlier this month. Responding to queries at press club, Chairperson stated that deserving women left out in previous survey conducted in 2010 under last government would be covered in the re-survey. BISP would make sure that no deserving remains deprived of financial assistance from BISP as Balochistan is on priority. She also briefed local folk about new payment mechanism and complimentary initiatives of BISP and further added that being the directory of real poor, updated NSER would be an asset for all.

Updated NSER would contribute towards effective policy making and better targeted programs as incumbent government believes in work and serving people are its mandate. BISP will initiate resurvey by middle of this year in fifteen districts and a tribal agency namely Mirpur (AJK), Charsadda, Lakki Marwat, Haripur (KPK), Chakwal, Layyah, Faisalabad, Bahawalpur (Punjab), Jacobabad, Sukkur, Thatta (Sindh), Gilgit (Gilgit Baltistan), Qila Saifullah, Kech, Naseerabad (Balochistan) and Mohammad Agency (FATA). After completion of the pilot phase, national roll out of resurvey will start in January 2017, it was further pointed out.
